**Exploration**  
Young people meet and discuss issues important to them



**Consultation**  
Young people meet with senior managers and talk through issues/ideas



**Feedback**  
Managers give feedback and/or go away to gather more information



**Decision Making**  
Managers feed back their decisions to young people and talk through the decision-making process where possible
