


Oberstown Campus Council Framework



Purpose and Objectives

- To improve day-to-day life for young people in order to ensure a safe, secure and fair environment for all.
- To ensure ongoing communication between young people and senior management.
- For young people to advocate for themselves and their future.
- For young people to be consulted on issues concerning them.
- To participate in projects and activities that may arise and that young people themselves initiate.
- To make services/policy/practice better based on consultation with young people.

How the council works

- Young people meet and discuss issues important to them.
- Young people meet with senior managers and talk through issues/ideas.
- Managers give feedback and/or go away to gather more information.
- Mangers feedback their decisions to young people and talk through the decision-making process where possible.

Guiding Principles

All participants have a responsibility to respect the process of the council as set out above. With this in mind:
